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FUNCTIONALITIES OF THE SERVICE REGISTRY

Verify the micro-credential

Our Service Registry is more than just a place to browse training opportunities. It is also a space where you can verify the authenticity of the micro-credentials you have earned.

The validation process must not be random – it should be based on quality management principles, clear criteria, and consistent procedures. That is why we have introduced a validator on our website that meets these requirements and enables reliable verification of acquired competences.

Our validator is intuitive and user-friendly. Simply paste the micro-credential into the grey field and click “Verify.”

Get access to our VR application!

Our VR application is a modern educational tool that supports the use of VR and AR technologies in learning. It enables knowledge acquisition through interactive scenarios and promotes awareness of the potential of these technologies among teachers, trainers, employers, and decision-makers.

Users can develop skills in areas such as computer graphics, website creation, CRM systems, 3D printing, employer branding, and working with gifted students. Each scenario showcases selected learning outcomes as practical examples of how VR can be applied in education.

The virtual environments replicate realistic, themed spaces, allowing free movement and interaction with educational elements. The experience unfolds in stages, with participants completing tasks in successive rooms.

WORKSHOPS TRAINING

First training workshop completed

On June 30th, a workshop dedicated to the use of VR technology in training processes concluded in Kraków. The event was organised by the Małopolska Regional Development Agency (MARR), which was the first among the project partners to complete this stage of activities. At the same time, a similar workshop was taking place in Tuscany.

The workshop was attended by 10 participants who, over the course of 50 hours of sessions, explored how virtual reality can be used in education and the development of soft skills. The focus was primarily on practical exercises and interactive learning methods.

More workshops are coming in July

DEKAPLUS is already up and running. More partners will start soon

On July 5th, another pilot workshop began in Cyprus as part of the project, focusing on the use of VR technology in training processes.

The workshop is organized by DEKAPLUS Business Services Ltd, which invited participants to their headquarters in Limassol. The sessions will last until July 29th and will focus on training ten people in the practical use of VR tools in education and implementing soft skills training in an immersive environment.

Shortly after, on July 14th, the Italian company Euro-Net will start its activities by organizing a workshop in Potenza. Then, in the second half of the month, the Polish company Syntea S.A. will also conduct its pilot.

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
